The Roatan Institute for Marine Sciences (RIMS) is excited to offer a 4-week Dolphin Training & Research Internship this summer. The internship is open to undergraduate students or recent graduates. Students will live and work at our facility and gain valuable research and field experience on some of the most beautiful and ecologically diverse reefs in the Caribbean.

## To apply you must complete the following 3 steps

**Step 1**: You must complete and submit this application form. The RIMS Dolphin Training & Research Internship Application is a fillable PDF form that can be submitted as an attachment directly to <a href="mailto:internship@roatanims.org">internship@roatanims.org</a>. The subject line of the email should be: **Last name**, **First name - RIMS Dolphin Internship Application**.

**Step 2**: You must submit an up-to-date transcript from your university. Unofficial transcripts will be accepted but only in PDF format. The subject line of the email should be: Last name, First name - RIMS Dolphin Internship Transcript.

**Step 3**: You must provide 2 letters of reference from a professor or job supervisor. One of these letters must be from a professor who has taught you in a science related class or research capacity. These must be sent directly from your professor/job supervisor. The subject line of the email should be: **Last name, First name - RIMS Dolphin Internship Reference.** 

Transcripts and references should also be mailed to: internship@roatanims.org

It is your responsibility to ensure that both letters of reference from professors/job supervisors are received before the deadline. Applications will not be considered until all three steps have been completed.

Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
